



'SALA IL - KBIRA':


Spacious hall with direct access to the outside, including a pleasant reception area.

How to Arrive:

Fly to the Malta International Airport, and then take the ferry (25 minutes) to Gozo.

Accommodation:

Sports:

PLACES OF INTEREST AT TA' CENC:

The whole land surrounding the Hotel, up to the sea, belongs to the hotel, (150 hectares) and it is considered of high archaeological interest.



Places of Interest

CART RUTS

It is possible to see the Cart Ruts in Ta' Cenc land, by walking through the promenade between the swimming pools, following the stone wall towards the cliffs up to the end and turning right. The Cart ruts will be starting next to another old stone wall (on it's right), about twenty meters away. The Cart Ruts are traces of parallel ruts said to have been caused by the huge rocks of the Neolithic dragged to the site. It is unknown, the use of the ruts in the Neolithic ages, giving space to various theories.

DOLMENS

The remains of Neolithic Dolmens can be found in the Ta' Cenc territory as 'id-Dura tal-Mara, id-Dura tax-Xaghra l-Kbira and id-Dura tal-Imramma'. Unfortunately no standing dolmens are left in the surround area.

It is possible to see the remains of the Neolithic Dolmens by going out by the promenade between the swimming pools and turning left. You will find them just next to the tree by the street.

TA' CENC CLIFFS

One of the most beautiful views of the Maltese islands, are the Ta' Cenc Cliffs

The sheer cliffs descending to the sea are over 140 meters of white globigerina limestone.

The majestic Ta' Cenc Cliffs can easily be seen by going out by the promenade between the swimming pools and follow the path on the right hand side.

For photography lovers, just before sunset is the most fascinating

PALAZZO PALINA

For conferences, incentives and cocktail receptions Hotel Ta' Cenc offers the impressive *Palazzo Palina*, situated on the hotel grounds

According to historians, Palazzo Palina, was built during the period of 1697 – 1720, the time that the Grand Master Ramon Perellos Y Roccaful was ruling the Maltese Islands. The coat-of-arms found there confirm the belief that it was constructed under his authority. One of the Knights of the Order of St. John was stationed there to look after the Ta' Cenc Territory (total area 1.5 square kilometres)

TOWFR

At the front entrance of the Hotel reception area, there is a tower which has become the logo of Hotel Ta' Cenc. The tower was originally used to bake limestone blocks that would eventually turn into a fine powder which is used as a base for white wash on buildings. The Maltese call this Lime Kiln – 'Kalkara tal-Gir'

KANTRA BEACH

Our private rocky beach, known for hundreds of years as 'Kantra', because of its savage beauty and its limpid clear waters, it is located in the rocky fjord inlet of 'Mgarr ix-Xini'. It provides a bar and grill restaurant, rich with fresh fish and meat, sunbeds, umbrellas and shower/toilet facilities. A minibus service which take you directly to the beach in five minutes is free of charge.
